

# What is Curbside?

Curbside Recycling is North Platte's newest way to recycle! The City of North Platte and KNPLCB have received a grant through the Nebraska Environmental Trust to develop a curbside recycling program here in our community. Now recycling can be as easy as walking out your front door!

# Curbside Rules

The yellow topped newspaper bins will be converted into Curbside Recycling bins and no longer just for newspapers.

Your recyclables can be comingled (except for the bagging of paper) and will be picked up every other week.

The Curbside bins will be placed along side your regular trash bin.

There is no fee for a bin.

If you do not think you can fill the 90 gallon bin every two weeks, please feel free to share with a neighbor or two. The bin will remain registered to the name who called to request it initially.

You cannot use just any bin you see.

Please be in agreeance with the registered user or call in to request your own.

# Accepted Items



*Plastics #1 and #2*

*Look for the chasing arrows symbol on the bottom!*

*Aluminum*



*Steel / Tin Cans*



*Cardboard / Paperboard*  
*Please break down.*

*Mixed Paper*  
*Must be bagged and tied to keep dry!*



# More Info

Although it is not enforced, it is preferred that lids be taken off.

ALL paper MUST be bagged and tied before being placed in the bin. This helps ensure the paper stays dry for recycling.

Please NO trash or yard waste in the Curbside bins. Accepted recyclables ONLY!

Please break down your cardboard to conserve space!

# Frequent Q & As

Who can sign up for a free Curbside Recycling bin?

This program is available to all private citizens within North Platte city limits.

What if I had a yellow topped newspaper bin registered to me that I shared with neighbors?

These carts have been converted over to Curbside Recycling bins. You can choose to continue sharing with your neighbor or encourage them to call for one of their own. An agreement with neighbors should be in place prior to sharing the bin.

What items are accepted?

Plastics #1 and #2, steel and tin cans, aluminum, cardboard, paperboard, and mixed paper.

Are compostable items or lawn debris accepted?

No other items will be accepted other than those listed in this brochure and on the lid of the bin.

Where will they pick my bin up at?

Your Curbside Recycling bin should be placed next to your regular trash bin.
